

## Contributions to *Neckera* (Neckeraceae, Musci) in China

*Neckera pusilla* Mitt. (from Shanxi), *N. bhutanensis* Nog. (Xizang) and *N. denigricans* Enroth (Yunnan) are reported for the first time from China and their locations are shown on a map. *Neckera pusilla* and *N. bhutanensis* are illustrated in line drawings. The sporophytes of *N. denigricans*, which was previously known only from the gametophyte generation, are described. A list of the accepted names of *Neckera* species reported from China is provided.
